From 11am today, incidents of stone throwing will end, barricades will be lifted, trenches dug across roads will be filled.

At the same time, police will withdraw their vehicles and personel from the Internal Stability Unit from the main township entrance.

Local police will be allowed to patrol businesses - especially near the township main entrance.

The police will not conduct any policing in Kuyasa until the next meeting of the local peace initiative, on Thursday July 29, without consulting at least two of six specified community leaders

The agreement will be re-considered at the meeting of the local peace committee on Thursday July 29, at the civic centre; open to any concerned organisation.

OOREENKOMS

Vanaf 11 vm. op Vrydag 16 Julie sal klipgooiery eindig, barikades in Kuyasa sal verwyder word en die slote wat in die pad gegrawe is, sal opgevul word.

Terselfdertyd sal die polisie alle voertuie en personeel van die Interne Stabiliserings-eenheid by die ingang van Kuyasa onttrek. Die plaaslike polisie sal voortgaan om plaaslike besighede te patroleer, veral die naby die hoofingang van Kuyasa.

Die polisie sal ook geen polisiëring in Kuyasa uitvoer tussen Vrydag 16 Julie tot en met Donderdag 29 Julie, tensy hulle eers ten minste twee leiers van die gemeenskap geraadpleeg het nie. Ses leiers is geidentifiseer.

Hierdie ooreenkoms sal heroorweeg word op die vergadering van die plaaslike vredeskomitee op Donderdag 29 Julie, om 14h00. Hierdie vergadering is oop vir enige organisasie of besorgde lid van die publiek.

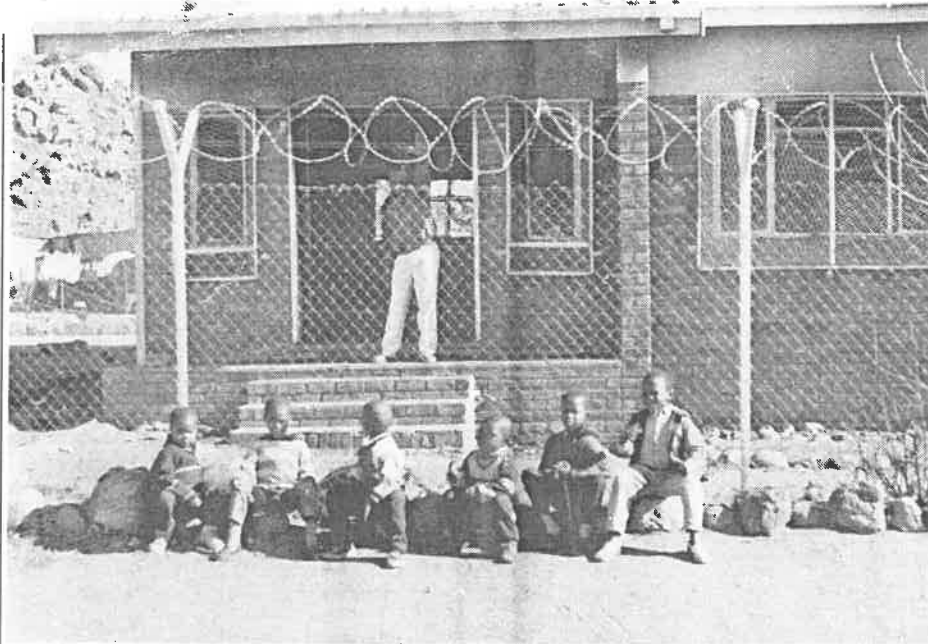
Unrest halts?

Colesberg's community organisations and officials agreed last night at a special meeting, that the unrest in the town should stop.

background

- * unrest since June 16 has centred on the large Kuyasa township. Demands are that police should keep out, and the hungry and jobless be helped.
- * the township takes the brunt. This is where fear and insecurity are highest; where most shops, vehicles & homes, have been attacked, burnt or looted.
- * here are the sharpest disagreements: including, between the ANC and the Civics.
- * the civics - which grew from and cultivated the unemployed workers union and youth - has turned to arguing with them.
- * both civic and ANC leadership have been attacked or threatened.
- * a criminal group are in with the protesters.
- * the whole town is netted in the unrest. Black, brown and white live on and share rumours, fears, angers, threats of retaliation...
- * there are endless meetings. There is much difference between the hawks and the doves...
- * there is tension in the wide gap between haves and havenots.
- * all are on the edge of transition in local, regional and national government. Many want to get on with this - but say preparations are impossible.
- * many can see no change in their lives over the past 3 years of expectation. There is disillusion.
- * the unrest has deep roots; including disruption by pupil leaders of the 900-strong high school since February this year.
- * these leaders "closed" the school just before June 16.
- * some people, (both black and white), have taken the law into their own hands.
- * there is sporadic provocation. Small children fire slings into the main street. Township adults, say police are often provocative.
- * money for numbers of development and housing problems, and jobs, are sidelined by suspicion and dispute.

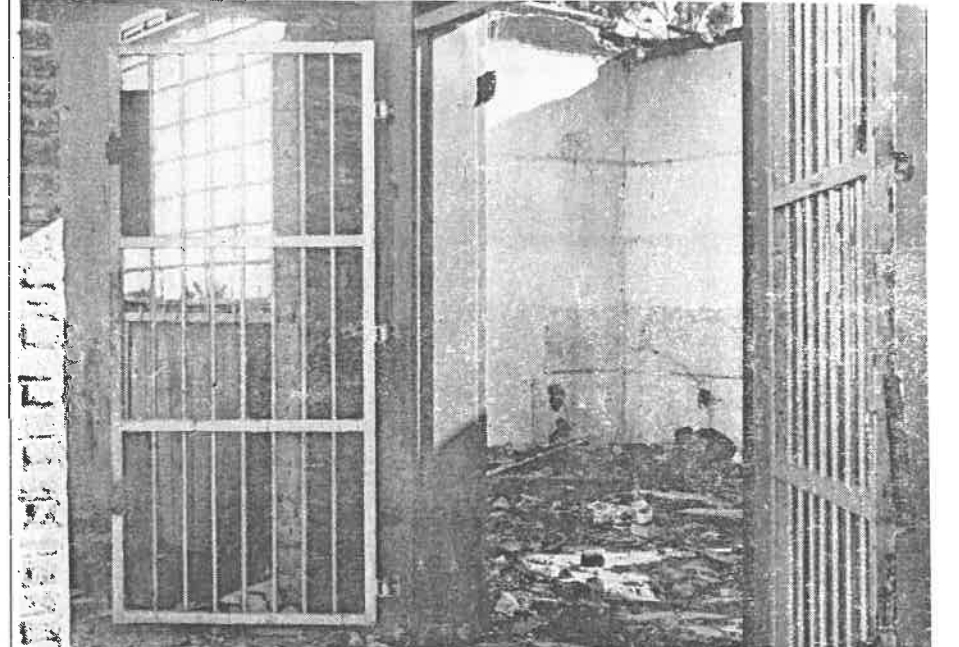
UDUSHE ECOLESBERG

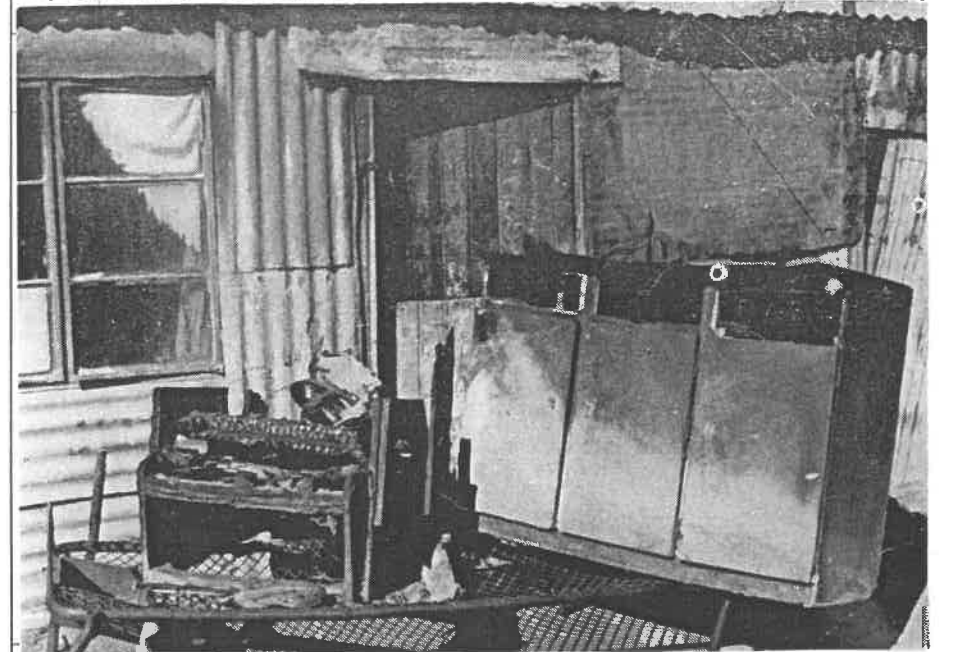
